

# Winter Season FAQ's

### What time will my game be in winter?

Teams will play a minimum of 3 games each winter round. These games are 30mins in duration. The approximate times for each division are as follows:

- 12&U Mixed 9am-1:00pm
- 14&U Boys and Girls 1pm-6pm
- 16&U Boys and Girls 9am-1:00pm
- Youth League 8am-3pm

\*Note these times may slightly vary depending on entries.

## Do I need to pay \$30 for each team I play in?

No. If you play on Saturday you will need to pay \$30 to your club. If you play on Sunday you will need to pay \$30 to your club. Players who play on both days will need to pay \$60 to your club.

#### Who does table duty for each game?

Each team that is playing needs to provide 1 person each to do table duty for their own game. It is a great opportunity to learn how to do table duty as it is less complex than normal.

#### What is the youngest a player can be to participate in Youth League?

Players must be born 2009 or later to participate in Youth League.
