# **Rep Program Screenings** Water Polo

In 2023, WPACT has introduced a performance health component into the representative program. We are super exciting to provide our players with the tools to take their games to the next level and stay in the water as long as possible.

The program is being led by Scott Wilson, a Sports and Exercise Physiotherapist who has professional experience across Australia.

WPACT has partnered with the University of Canberra school of Physiotherapy to provide screenings to all our athletes to identify potential injury risks and to come up with a plan to address them. The first screenings took place last weekend with the second round happening this weekend at University of Canberra.

Over 80 athletes will have screenings completed which is a huge step in having a better understanding of our athletes and being able to take steps to look after them.
