National State Championships

As a result of stakeholder consultation, the State Associations and Water Polo Australia have agreed to change the delivery of the National State Championships, commencing in the 2024-2025 season.

The 15&U and 17&U Men's and Women's National State Championships will be held at the same time, in the same venue, slated for 26-30 September 2024 on the Gold Coast.

The 19&U National State Championships will transition to a talent identification camp, with further details as well as dates and venues to be released in the near future.

WPACT will work with WPA on key selection criteria to ensure we send a competitive team that meets the purpose of the tournament, whilst supporting a representative pathway for WPACT members.




