Position Purpose

The role of the Age Group Coordinator is to provide support to the Representative Team Coach, athletes, parents and WPACT to achieve the best possible results in the State and/or National tournament.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist with the distribution of information from WPACT to the athlete and parent group.
- Be the point of contact for athletes and parents who may have questions related to the WPACT representative program. Liaise with WPACT staff to ensure a consistent message is passed on;
- Maintain the "Heja" platform for your age group to ensure athletes and parents are receiving information;
- Coordinate squad/team meetings on behalf of the coach to set down expectations;
- Liaise with draft players/parents once appointed to WPACT teams;
- Attend WPACT briefing sessions and Age Group Coordinator meetings;
- Assist with booking logistics and preparing budgets if required;
- Maintain accurate financial records through the "Weel" platform.
- Assist with the distribution of uniforms once they arrive.
- Act in the team manager role on tour for your age group.
- Coordinate team fundraising initiatives.

The coaching resume and/or expression of interest should include all essential qualifications and experience.

Step 2: If shortlisted, participate in mandatory interviews between Tuesday 2nd April – Friday 5th April 2024.

Step 3: Age Group Coordinator appointments will be finalised at the April WPACT Board meeting.
